Happy Passover! April 5 -13th

Passover, also called Pesach, is a major Jewish holiday that celebrates the Biblical story of the Israelites escape from slavery in Egypt. The festival of Passover is one of great joy. It takes place for about one week in March or April. A special family meal called a seder is held the first and sometimes the second night of Passover.

Ramadan – March 22nd was the First Day of the Holy Month of Ramadan - the month of fasting, self-examination and devotion during which physically able Muslims to not eat or drink from the first sign of dawn until sunset.

Good Friday_– April 7th In Christianity, recognizes the day Christ was crucified. Is an official statutory holiday in Canada.

Vesak/Wesak/Buddha Day/Visakha Puja_– April 8th. Buddha's birthday - usually on the first full moon day in May, this the most important day that commemorates the birth, awakening and passing away of the historical Buddha; Siddhartha Gautama

*Easter Sunday*_– Sunday, April 9th Recognizes the resurrection of Christ. Also celebrated as non-secular event by many Canadians.

What is Discord?

Discord is a free online messaging platform that allows users to create groups chats. Once invited into a chat, users can remain anonymous and message others without identifying who they are.

For elementary aged students, this can cause many different social issues and create anxiety when mean or inappropriate things are added to the chat. Discord is NOT a supervised platform and Elementary aged students should not be accessing this messaging platform.

The Discord policy states that the minimum age for an account is 13 years old.

Please check in with your child regarding Discord and we STRONGLY encourage all online experience be supervised by a parent.
