We do not accept food delivery services of any kind in the office. Please make alternate arrangements.

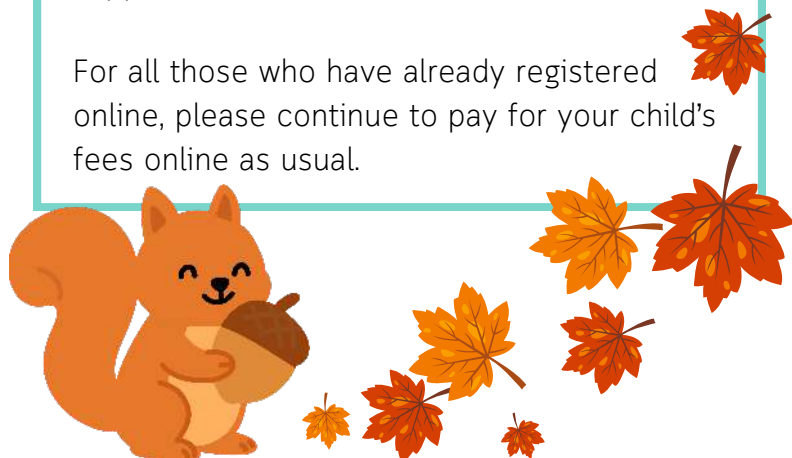

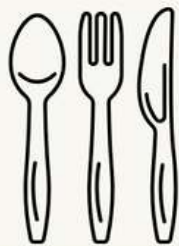
