November 5, 2025 (Sikh)



We extend our heartfelt greetings to Sikh students, staff, and families as you celebrate the Gurpurab (birth anniversary) of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the founder of Sikhism.

May this sacred day bring peace, wisdom, and inspiration to all.

Translation note: Gurpurab combines Guru (teacher) and Purab (celebration/occasion), referring to a day that commemorates a Guru's birth or significant life event.

Pronounced: GOOR-poo-rub
Guru Nanak Dev Ji (ਗੁਰੂ ਨਾਨਕ ਦੇਵ ਜੀ) is honoured as the first Sikh Guru and spiritual teacher.
