### Quviasukvik

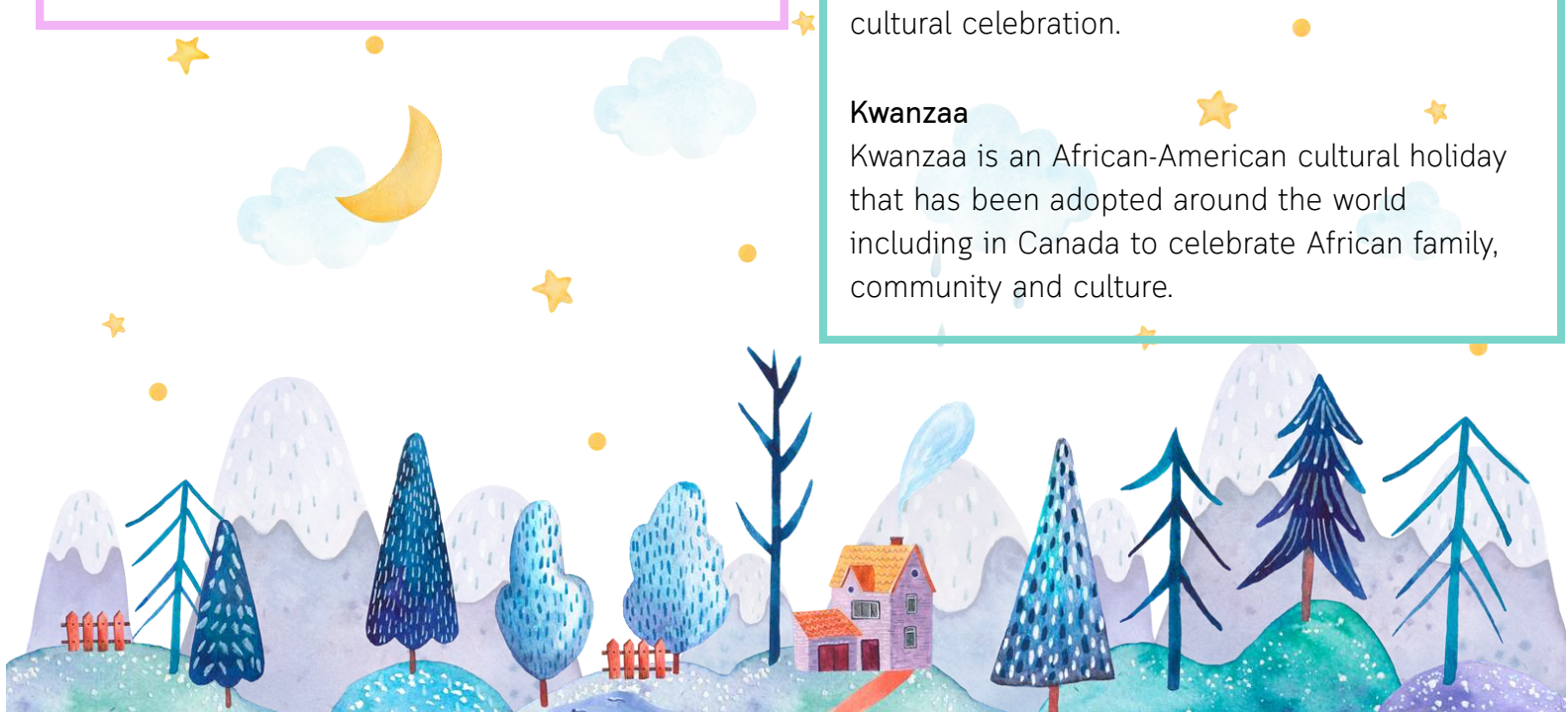

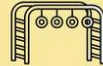

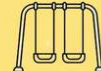
