Dear Parents and Families,

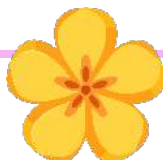
Spring Break is finally here! 🌸

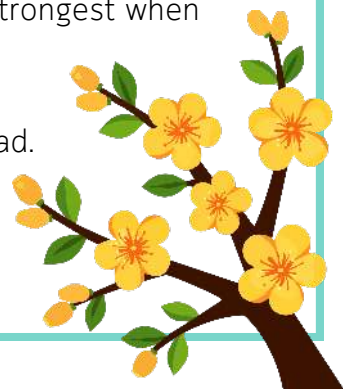

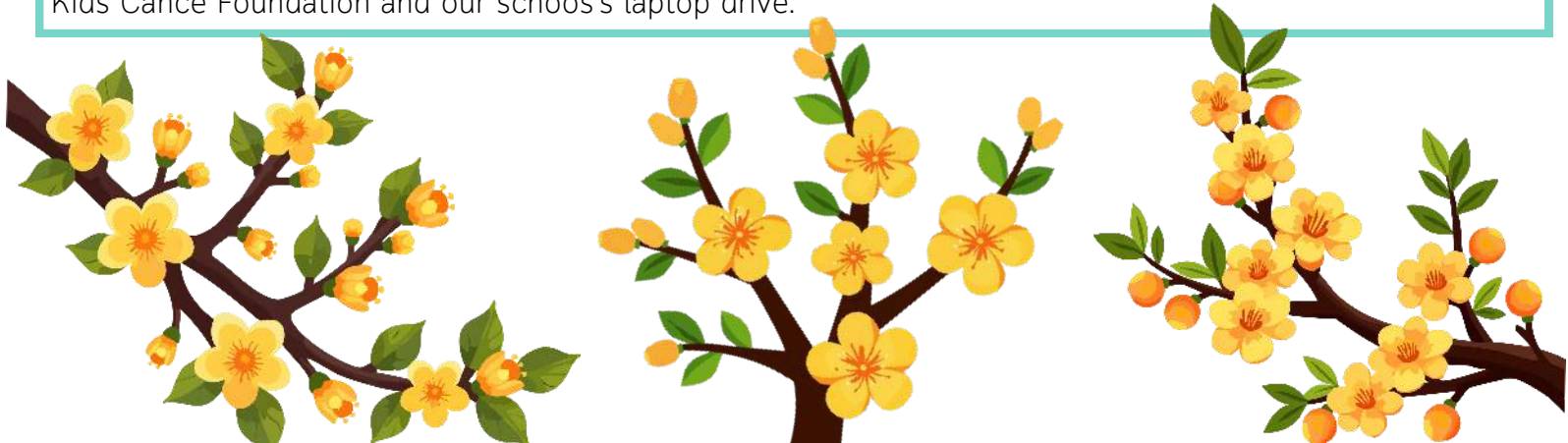
A UN day created to highlight issues of health across the globe.
