Powwow & Hoop Dance Cultural Presentation

On June 9, Anderson students enjoyed a presentation by Chelsei Gray and Noah Gray, sibling Powwow and Hoop Dance artists who share their gifts as dancers and cultural educators.

Chelsei and Noah proudly come from Sq'ewlets, located in the heart of Stó:lō territory, as well as from the Quw'utsun people of the Cowichan Valley (Coast Salish).

Together, they introduced students to Fancy Shawl, Grass Dance, and Hoop Dance styles, blending performance with teachings about regalia, movement, and cultural meaning.

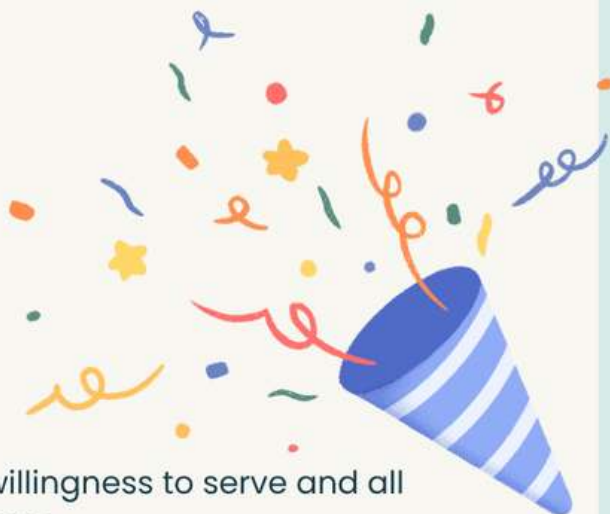
