## 2. Updates from the School

- As of Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>, there are approximately 450 students in school and 142 students doing transitional learning.

- Transitional Learners also have new schedules as well as new teachers due to the number of students that have returned to school and the teachers availability.

- Ms. Yau's class is creating a collaborative art project for the entire school about kindness.
- Grade 5 DARE program has started. The students have their own set of videos and booklets to work through. The final graduation will be on Zoom.

- Feb 24<sup>th</sup> is Pink Shirt Day.
