1. Minutes from previous meeting

Approved. Moved by C. Burke, Seconded by M. Walic, all were in favour.

Principal's Report 2.

- As of April 5th, there are approximately 70 students are still on transitional learning. The School is encouraging parents to send their kids back anytime.
- Ministry of education learning survey for parents was sent out and the school is working on a learning experience survey with the kids. 2 surveys have been sent out, one by the district and one by Ministry of Education – both are important and should be completed by parents.
- April 14th is early dismissal. Some teachers are doing remote parent teacher conferences.
- The school is having a Zoombly for Earth Day, April 22 some videos, posters, community space clean ups etc will be a part of the celebration.
- Photo Day: Using a new company, Edge Imaging. They are willing to do composites for Class Photos.
- Projected number of students for 2021-2022 year at Anderson is 602 students, which is around the same as last year. Many students remain on the waiting list.
- Jump Rope for Heart is being organized with online fundraising with the students.
- FSA results have been received by the school and did well overall. Most students were on track or extending. The tests will go home with the students soon. Fewer participation this year because of covid and the transitional learning students did not participate.
- Raseel, parent of Hayat in Gr. 5, has donated 375 bags of date paste to the school. A notice will be sent to all parents so they can pick up dates from the school.
- **REQUEST** for PAC to fund: A Composite group photo for Gr. 7s, \$16 each x 51 grads = \$806.
 - ACTION: Need to check with D. Lum in regards to PAC funding the medals for the Gr. 7s last year or not.

3. Treasurer's Report

- On May 3rd, G. Lam will join the teachers meeting as a guest speaker to discuss planning for September and how we can to work together for the enrichment of the children. Also, a wish list from the teachers to the PAC would be nice to budget more effectively.
- PAC will advertise that parents can donate money to the school. If you donate through School Cash Online with \$20+, parents will get a tax receipt, however, PAC has no say in where that money is spent. If you donate through PAC via e-transfer, you will not get a tax receipt but PAC has a say in where the money is spent.
