How your school can participate

Parents, Teachers, or Admin can register their school for free at bikehub.ca/btsw. **Earlybird registration is open until April 18** and schools registering by that date are entered to win 1 of 3 Bike Maintenance sessions for their students.

When registering, schools choose how they would like to receive their event package.

Event packages include:

- Large poster and stickers to track students' trips
- Promotional posters to spread the word
- Incentives for students
