## SPIRIT DAY, FRIDAY, DEC 20

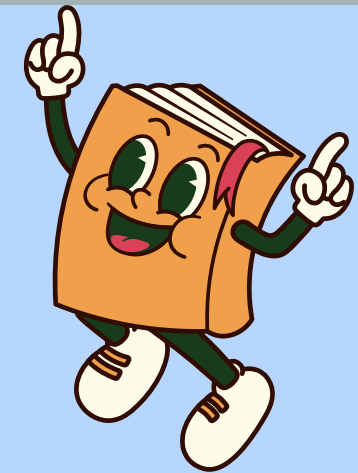


Students can wear any of the following to show their school spirit:
