In each iteration of our invention, our creation becomes better and better.



We build our understanding that it is not an innate ability that builds our skills, but passion, a strong work ethic, and time. There is research on the benefits of a growth mindset for our well-being, and research also shows that children with growth mindsets outperform kids with a more fixed mindset and bounce back quicker from failures.


INDEXAMENS THROUGH TIME WELL DONE STUDENTS!




