

## SCHOOL FEES

ANDERSON HAS GONE COMPLETELY ONLINE!

The Richmond Board of Education offers the opportunity to purchase basic school supplies through the school at a cost of \$33.00 for the year. This is a great value and we encourage you to purchase your child's supplies at school.

Basic school supplies include exercise books, duotang covers, looseleaf pages, key tabs, scrapbooks, erasers, pencils, pens, wax crayons, pencil crayons and glue sticks. Students will be provided with these supplies as needed throughout the year.

An additional \$6.00 for student agendas will be added to the total for students in Grade 1 through 7, bringing the total to \$39.00.

  - This form covers media release permissions for photos and videos taken during school activities.
- Fair Notice for Parents (White)
  - If you're interested in volunteering to drive for field trips this year, this form will help you begin the approval process.
- Accident Insurance (White)
  - If you would like to purchase additional insurance coverage for your child(ren).

Please return the Student Verification Form, Walking Field Trip Permission Form and Personal Information Consent Form to your classroom teacher as soon as possible.
