UN International Day of Persons with Disability

Hanukkah

Winter Solstice (Northern Hemisphere)

The shortest period of daylight and the longest night of the year. This date is celebrated by, and has significance to, multiple cultures and religions.

Quviasukvik

Inuit winter feast and festival observed by the Inuit, Yupik, Aleut, Chukchi, Iñupiat, and NunatuKavut. Celebrates the coming year and placates the roaming spirits for good luck in the year to come.

Christmas Day

A Christian holiday commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ, usually observed as a religious and cultural celebration.

Kwanzaa

Kwanzaa is an African-American cultural holiday that has been adopted around the world including in Canada to celebrate African family, community and culture.
