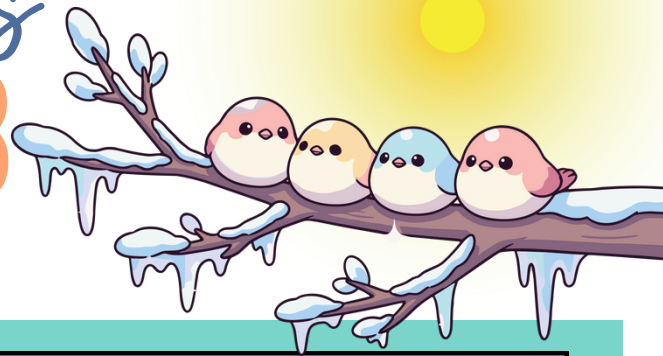

Hello Anderson Grade 7 families,

We are excited to announce that on Monday, May 25, our grade 7 students will have the opportunity to go to Camp Cheakamus for a one-day outdoor education/field study program. Camp Cheakamus is located in beautiful Squamish, British Columbia, and is owned and operated by the North Vancouver School District (NVSD). It is an environmental studies facility located on 165 hectares of ecological preserve in Paradise Valley. We will be traveling by Perimeter Transportation coach bus to and from Camp Cheakamus, and the students will spend the day participating in their Field Studies program, which is aligned with our BC curriculum and supports the Ministry of Education's learning objectives and core competencies.

All families with a current cell phone number in our MyEdBC database will receive a text message from SchoolMessenger (Text #: 978338) in February 2026. To start receiving text alerts, you will need to opt in.

How to opt in:

1. Watch for a text from SchoolMessenger (Text #: 978338).
2. Reply with "Y" to 978338.
3. You will receive a confirmation message letting you know you're successfully subscribed.

Want alerts on more than one device?

To receive text alerts on multiple phones, each phone number must opt in separately by replying "Y" to 978338.
