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Dear Parent or Guardian:

This year, Vancouver Coastal Health Public Health Dental Hygienists will be offering dental screening to your child's kindergarten class. Screening helps to identify children who may be experiencing health problems, which can affect their health and learning. The goal is to identify disease early and provide your family with oral health resources.

Screening will be done on Thursday February 19 2026 starting at 9:00 AM in the school.

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Dental Hygienists will:

Check all children's teeth, whether they have or have not seen a dentist before. They will complete a quick visual check using a tongue depressor and flashlight. This dental screening does not replace seeing a dentist.

If we find any concerns with your child's oral health, we will let you know. A letter will be sent home with information about your child's screening and if there is a need for further testing or follow up.

**If you do not wish your child to be screened, please call the phone number below at least one week before to the screening date. If you choose not to participate in the screening, this will not affect your child receiving other services or in the quality of care provided. If you do not contact us, we will screen your child.**

The screening results will be held confidential and the information about your child's screening will be recorded in your child's health record at the Health Unit. The information collected is to support your child's referral and follow up with VCH. We make sure that this information stays private. We collect, use and share this information only as allowed by law: The British Columbia Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
